MAY HAVE LARGER STEM BASE, BUT NO VOLVA

CAP IS CONVEX TO FLAT WITH GILLS UNDERNEATH

- CROWN-LIKE
   PARTIAL VEIL THAT
   IS LEFT BEHIND ON
   STEM (CAN FALL OFF
   OR BE STUCK TO RIM
   OF CAP)
- WINE-RED WHEN
  YOUNG FADING TO
  LIGHT BROWN WITH
  AGE
- PURPLEISH SPORE PRINT
- WHITE GILLS ON UNDERSIDE WHEN YOUNG TURNING GREY-PURPLE WITH AGE
- GILLS ATTACHED TO BUT NOT RUNNING DOWN STEM

- NO X
- NO VOLVA(EGG-LIKE CUP AT BASE OF STEM)
- NO WHITE SPORE PRINT
- NO PORE SURFACE
- NO LARGE SCALES ON CAP
